- ❖ Proof of Haitian nationality
- ❖ Information about your immigration history, including the date you first came to the U.S.
- ❖ Documents that can show when you entered the United States and any documents that show you were in the United States on or before January 12, 2010
- ❖ Any immigration documents you filed or received
- ❖ If you can afford to pay for a TPS application, bring a check or money order made out to “U.S. Department of Homeland Security” to mail with your application (NO CASH)! The fees are as follows:
 - TPS application + work permit = \$470
 - TPS only (no work permit) = \$130
 - Kids under 14 = \$50
 - Over 65 = \$130
- ❖ If you cannot afford to pay, we will file a request to waive the fee--bring documents that show:
 - Any benefits you are receiving
 - Anything to prove your income
 - Anything showing you have large expenses, such as high medical bills
